Jean-Pierre (JP) Nel, a Stope team member at Masimong Operations - originally from Welkom, one of Harmony's host communities in the Free State - is just one of many employees who used the opportunities MQA provided to soar to new heights. At a young age, JP became the bread winner of his family, supporting his



mother and sister, after his father Mr. John Nel sadly passed away in a minerelated accident. Having left high school in grade 9 to step in for his father, JP had to transition from an Afrikaans background into a corporate environment where English is the primary medium of communication.

Despite the challenges he faced, he saw an opportunity to further his education with the Harmony Adult Education and Training (AET) programme and in just two years he successfully completed four AET levels and is

preparing to enrol for NQF Level 1. Not only does JP now speak English with confidence, but he also aspires to continue his studies in the hopes of becoming an engineer one day.

JP's story highlights the incredible strides the programme has made in ensuring success for employees. At Harmony, we recommit ourselves to ensuring continued success in building a literate, skilled and empowered workforce in collaboration with the MQA, the Department of Higher Education, Department of Science and Innovation, and all our partners in labour and communities.
