This commitment came to life once again at the 2026 Enactus South Africa National Exposition, held in Johannesburg from 22 to 23 July 2026, where Harmony proudly served as the anchor sponsor. The event brought together South Africa's brightest student entrepreneurs, business leaders, academics and development partners, all united by a shared vision of using entrepreneurship to solve some of the country's most pressing challenges.

The exposition celebrated more than innovative business ideas. It showcased the potential of young South Africans to become job creators, community leaders and problem-solvers who are building a more inclusive and sustainable future.

A highlight of the event was the Harmony Food & Health Security, Employability & Entrepreneurship Enactus Challenge, which challenged university students to develop sustainable enterprises that improve food and health security while creating employment opportunities in their communities.

This year's challenge attracted an impressive 128 entries from universities across South Africa. Following a rigorous adjudication process led by Harmony executives, 10 teams received implementation grants of R12 000 each, enabling them to transform promising ideas into practical, community-driven enterprises. Six outstanding finalists progressed to the national finals, demonstrating innovative solutions ranging from sustainable agriculture and hydroponics to food production and community nutrition.

During the awards ceremony on 23 July 2026, the finalists were recognised for their innovation, resilience and commitment to creating meaningful social impact through entrepreneurship. Together, they shared R30 000 in prize money, providing further support to scale their enterprises and deepen their impact within their communities.

As the winning Enactus South Africa team prepares to represent the country at the Enactus World Cup in São Paulo, Brazil, later this year, Harmony remains proud to be part of a partnership that has empowered generations of student entrepreneurs since 2006.

For Harmony, this event reflected far more than a sponsorship. It demonstrated the company's long-term commitment to youth empowerment as a strategic investment in South Africa's future. By supporting platforms such as Enactus, Harmony is helping equip young people with the entrepreneurial, leadership and problem-solving skills needed to address unemployment, strengthen local economies and build sustainable livelihoods.
